AAU hosted Al Ain City Municipality to talk about its role in preserving the environment

In Collaboration with the College of Law at Al Ain University of Science and Technology –Al Ain Campus- the Deanship of Student Affairs organized a lecture about “The Role of Al Ain City Municipality in the Preservation of the Environment and Public Health”, which was presented by Mrs. Ebtisam Al Shamsi – Coordinator of the Environment, Health and Safety at Al Ain Municipality- and Mr. Ammar Al Mansour and was attended by a number of faculty members and students of the College of Law.

The lecture talked about the environment, health and safety management system in Al Ain and Abu Dhabi municipalities, and the procedures in the control field, in addition to the most important legal and legislative systems regarding the public health and the environment, in addition to the terms of the legislation, and the health requirements for the environment, health and safety that must be followed in all facilities and institutions, and followed by the consequent

of fines and penalties for violators.

This lecture aimed to achieve knowledge, promote awareness among students, and to know the required procedures to be followed to achieve the public health and how to deal with it in the event of discovery of any violations and how to report to the competent authorities in the municipality.
